## *Programme*

The festival will commence with a People's Parliament to launch our first draft of the Food Sovereignty Act. We invite you to join us – as we invite members of government, civil society organisations, religious organisations and members of the public to take part in this historic process and comment on our draft food sovereignty law.

Thereafter the Food Sovereignty Festival will commence. The festival serves as a platform to share information, celebrate food sovereignty alternatives in Africa and to learn about how we can build people's power. The festival will run for the rest of day and comprise of:

- One-hour long info sessions: including documentary screenings, panel discussions, dialogues and demonstrations. These sessions will cover topics such as the food crisis in Africa; struggles for food sovereignty; tools for building food sovereignty, including creative campaigning strategies, tours of the greenhouse project, inner city rooftop gardens and indigenous cooking classes to name a few.
- Exhibition space, market space and food court: This space will be available for the sale of fresh produce, seeds, and African meals. Organisations in the food sovereignty space will also be given an area to showcase their work and alternatives.
- Cultural evening: The day will end with a cultural evening of entertainment.

## *Parking*

Parking will be available on the Greenhouse Project premises on the corner of Klein and Wolmarans Street, Joubert Park. Overflow parking will be available at the Johannesburg Art Gallery.
